These stealthy braces often come with a slightly higher cost and not all orthodontists incorporate this technique. But if you're looking for a clean, uncluttered grin, you may be a candidate.

# **Blending In**

Translucent, clear braces may work if traditional straightening still fits you best, but you want to avoid the metal gleam. Your natural tooth color shows through both the brackets and the wires, reducing the contrast of materials in your smile.

Wires come in two varieties: clear plastic or white-coated metal. While white-coated versions provide the highest strength, plastic wires tend to maintain a better appearance over time. The ceramic or plastic brackets are extremely durable and stain resistant.

Although clear braces cost more than metal, they're a modern choice for toning down the metal-head look!



# Slip Sliding

At first glance, self-ligating braces may not seem much different than other options. Recent updates to this alternative method of treatment creates a few advantages. Most patients don't miss the large rubber bands that can be eliminated with this technique. The free-sliding wires reduce the

pressure applied to the teeth. Along with less discomfort, this results in fewer trips to the orthodontist and shorter adjustment times.

Self-ligating braces come in metal, ceramic, or clear, and all versions feature small, less cumbersome brackets than traditional braces.

### A Clear Look

For ultimate camouflage, tray systems offer a modern straightening method. Designed with sophisticated software and 3D models of your teeth, a series of clear plastic trays provide precise alignment pressure. Medical-grade plastic without wires, metal, springs, or



rubber bands move your teeth into place. Your provider dispenses several sets of aligners at one time, allowing you to change to a new one at home every 2 weeks

Removable trays can be set aside for short periods to allow normal eating and cleaning. Enjoying an apple without the intrusion of brackets and wires works well for many patients. And the smooth plastic surface offers a comfort level unequaled by other forms of straightening. While aligner treatment works for 90% of straightening cases, some tooth movements may not be possible.
